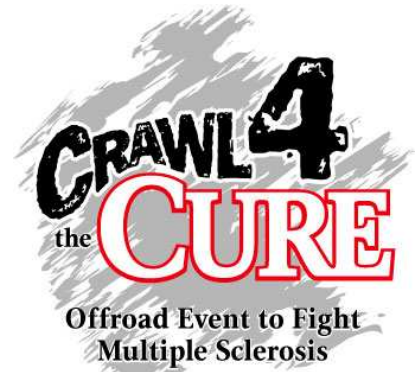


5th Annual Crawl for the Cure

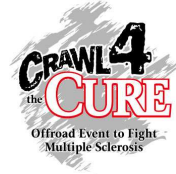


Pre registration instructions and Information:

- 1: Total cost for the event is \$250.00. This is collected via pledges from your sponsors (friends, family, coworkers etc.)
- 2: \$50.00 pre registration fee per trail ride registrant. This is included as part of the \$250.00 minimum event fee (you only need to collect a minimum of \$200.00 more)!
- 3: Send personal check or money order (absolutely no cash) payable to HTR 4x4 Club.
- 4: Pre registration holds your spot, for the event. You will need to bring \$200.00 more in pledges with you to the event in order to participate. This is money that you collect from friends, family, coworkers etc. These donations go directly to the MS Society.
- 5: \$250.00 is the minimum event fee.(preregistration & pledge money) You are certainly welcome to Raise more. The more you raise, the more tickets you will receive for the raffle on sat. evening.
- 6: One event registration includes Trail ride vehicle, driver & one passenger.
- 7: All extra passengers over age 16 are an additional \$20.00.
- 8: Camping is offered for a \$30.00 extra fee. If you are not camping, other accommodations will be your own responsibility. See other papers in this packet for Hotel info.

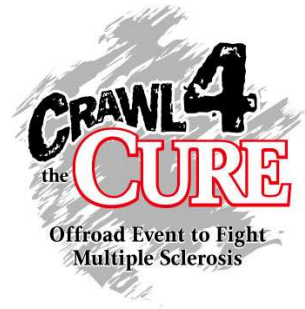
