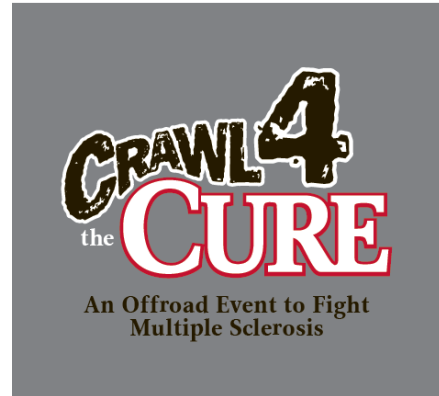

The Crawl 4 the Cure is held in the town of Gilbert, Minnesota at the state's first public off-road park. The park consists of tight winding trails, large hill climbs, and difficult rock crawling gorges. The park has been used with great success for national events in the past including Petersen's 4Wheel & Off-Road's Ultimate Adventure and a Jeep Jamboree.

Approximately 400,000 Americans acknowledge having MS, and every week about 200 people are diagnosed. Worldwide, MS may affect 2.5 million individuals. Our goal this year is \$50,000.
